

PACIBER 2010 Annual Meeting - Hilton Waikoloa Village, Waikoloa, Hawaii, USA

The PACIBER 2010 Annual Meeting was held at the Hilton Waikoloa Village, Hawaii, June 19-22, 2010. The theme was **Rethinking Business and Business Education**, attended by 36 faculty from 21 business schools from Taipei, China, the Philippines, Thailand, Malaysia, Australia, New Zealand, Colombia, Canada, and the US. Highlights included a keynote address by Chris Fussner, President, Transtechnology PTE (Singapore), on the Current and Future Impacts of the Global Financial Crisis, and Corporate Social Responsibility and Triple Bottom Line Performance; a panel discussion and paper presentations along the theme; site visit to the Natural Energy Laboratory of Hawaii Authority, including an address by Ron Baird, CEO, and visits to the deep sea water pump, an abalone farm, and deep sea water desalination and bottling plant; and regional updates and school updates by the participating faculty.



PACIBER 2009 Annual Meeting, Queenstown, New Zealand



The PACIBER 2009 Annual Meeting was held at the St. Moritz Hotel, Queenstown, New Zealand, July 3 – 6, 2009. The themes were "**Involving Indigenous and Minority Peoples in Internationalization**" and "**The Global Economic Crisis**". The meeting was attended by thirty-one faculty from seventeen business schools, representing ten countries in all four PACIBER regions (East Asia, Southeast Asia, Oceania, and the Americas). Highlights included keynote addresses by Sir Tipene O'Regan, Assistant Vice Chancellor (Maori) at the University of Canterbury, Ngai Tahu Kaumatua; and Grant Spencer, Deputy Governor and Head of Financial Stability, Reserve Bank of New Zealand; a presentation on "Doing Business in New Zealand" by Alan Richardson, NZ Trade and Enterprise; regional panels on the global economic crisis; research presentations on the themes; and school updates by the participating faculty.

PACIBER 2008 Annual Meeting, Hanoi, Vietnam

The PACIBER 2008 Annual Meeting was held at the Sofitel Plaza Hotel, Hanoi, Vietnam, July 5 – 8, 2008. The theme was "**Internationalization of Business in Transitional Economies**", attended by 38 faculty from 20 business schools. Highlights included a keynote address on higher education in Vietnam by Dr. Truong Gia Binh, Dean, Hanoi School of Business; a presentation on "Doing Business in Vietnam" by David Day, International Attorney; a panel discussion on Vietnam's financial environment by three local industry experts; and regional updates and school updates by the participating faculty.
