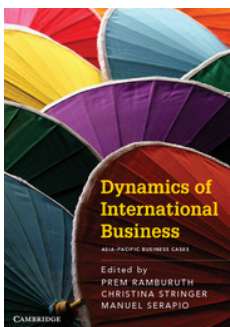


The PACIBER 2013 Annual Meeting marked PACIBER's 25th Anniversary. Hosted by Chulalongkorn University, the meeting was attended by 27 professors and 7 deans from 18 business schools representing South Korea, China, Taiwan, the Philippines, Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia, Singapore, Australia, New Zealand, Colombia, Canada, and the United States; 3 business executives from Singapore and Thailand; and joined by 25 Executive MBA students from the University of Hawaii.



The Annual Meeting celebrated 25 years of accomplishments and featured the release of



"Dynamics of International Business, Asia-Pacific Business Cases", a collaborative product produced by the PACIBER members and published by Cambridge University Press, showcasing 24 international business cases.

Dr. Olarn Chaipravat, Advisor to the Prime Minister, President of the Thailand Trade Representative and Former Deputy Prime Minister, presented the keynote address on the "Capitalism Model in Thailand", comparing and contrasting his PACIBER 2004 Phuket keynote address.



Regional updates for East Asia, Southeast Asia, Oceania, and the Americas were delivered in panel format and focused on the conference theme of Capitalism for the Long Term. Similarly, research paper presentations were aligned with the conference theme and led to stimulating discussion across and between the regions.



Discussions on PACIBER collaborative activities included faculty development workshops, joint research projects, enhancements and additions to the PACIBER casebook, and the PACIBER Diploma and school exchanges. Dr. Larry Crump led an interactive exercise on teaching international negotiation.

In celebrating PACIBER's 25th anniversary, a Thai cultural performance featured dancers and performers from Chulalongkorn University.
